The Emory Transplant Center recommends:

All transplant candidates and recipients, care partners, and eligible household contacts receive and stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines, including boosters, as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). COVID-19 vaccines may be required by some transplant programs. Additional information about COVID-19 vaccines and dosing schedules are available on the CDC website (<u>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/stay-up-to-date.html</u>).

- All transplant candidates and recipients receive and stay up to date with all additional vaccinations as recommended by the CDC. Vaccine information may be found on the CDC website (https://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/schedules/hcp/imz/adult-conditions.html).
- We encourage you to ask your provider any questions you may have about vaccines, including COVID-19, and your vaccination status.

For ease of access, we recommend going to your local retail pharmacy for COVID-19 vaccines. Continue to stay safe. You and your health and safety are very important to us.
