

### The Integrated Memory Care Clinic Team

The IMCC care team consists of nurse practitioners, collaborating physicians, a registered nurse, social worker, and a patient care coordinator.

The team will develop an individualized plan of care with treatment recommendations. Patient education, potential and actual barriers to treatment goals, caregiver and family support, and community resources may be discussed while developing the care plan.



Glenna Brewster, Nurse Practitioner-- Glenna is a Family Nurse Practitioner with experience in the primary care of older adults. She conducts dementia caregiver research and supports the IMCC team.



Carolyn Clevenger, Clinical Director & Nurse Practitioner – Carolyn has a Doctor of Nursing Practice from the Medical College of Georgia. As a nurse practitioner, she specializes in geriatrics and Alzheimer’s disease and related disorders. She sees patients for primary care in the IMCC.



Debbie Gunter, Nurse Practitioner– Debbie is nurse practitioner whose specialty is palliative care and geriatrics. She provides primary care to patients at the IMCC.



Theodore (Ted) Johnson II, Collaborating Physician—Dr. Johnson is a geriatrician and the chair of Emory’s Department of Family and Preventive medicine. He does not see patients within the IMCC, but he consults with the nurse practitioners.
